


Every year is a new beginning, a chance to have a fresh start with endless opportunities for growth and development. We're so glad you're considering our school.

What Is Achieve

What is a Charter School?

IT'S A TUITION-FREE, PUBLICLY-FUNDED SCHOOL. IT'S OPEN TO EVERYONE!

Charter schools are public schools that operate independently of local school districts. Instead of following a curriculum and testing standards set by the district, charter schools can design and adjust their goals to meet their students' needs (as long as they continue to meet specific state standards, like California State Common Core Standards). Parents, teachers, and other community members can come together to design curricula they believe will serve their students best.

Charter schools operate as 501c3 non-profit organizations, are open to the public, are tuition-free, participate in state tests, and employ credentialed teachers. Under the law, charter schools cannot discriminate based on disability, race, color, gender, national origin, religion, or ancestry. At Achieve Charter Schools, we're proud to welcome everyone, regardless of student background or ability, but because of our smaller schools and class sizes, we have an enrollment cap. Once we reach capacity, students will enter a lottery to attend.

As of 2022, there are over 1,300 charter schools serving over 700,000 charter school students in California.

Our Enrollment Process

At Achieve, we pride ourselves on having small schools and class sizes. This leads to a lottery system. Lottery applications are accepted during a publicly advertised open enrollment period, starting in January, for enrollment the following school year and the public random drawing is held in March.

How and Why Achieve Got Started

In 2005, a group of educators, community leaders, and parents opened the Achieve Charter School of Paradise together.

It was founded with the goal of making a positive impact on our students and families not only academically, but socially and emotionally. We aim to provide our community with a quality small-school option with individual learning opportunities to help students achieve their full academic and social potential.

What Makes Achieve Different

Q: What makes Achieve different from other schools?

A: Achieve offers personalized learning with high expectations while providing academic and social-emotional support. We've got a school-wide sense of community with an emphasis on character building. There is a strong commitment to diversity and inclusivity. Our classes are small by design, which means every child is known and belongs.

Q: What does learning at Achieve look like?

A: A day at Achieve starts with a daily morning assembly with songs, student recognition, announcements, reminders about expectations, and, most importantly, a focus on virtues. Students at Achieve benefit from Personalized Learning Plans (PLPs), virtues, mastery-based learning, and STEM Labs on our campuses. Our research-based instructional strategies are taught by highly qualified and trained teachers. Students are engaged and inspired, and the proof is in the pudding, with high attendance rates.

Q: What does Achieve offer beyond the curriculum?

A: Achieve recognizes the need for extra support for our students and provides art-based therapy and counseling for trauma, especially for those who experienced the 2018 Camp Fire. And we think school should include fun and games, of course! This is why Achieve has dedicated sports teams like volleyball, basketball, and even Esports.

Every year Achieve offers opportunities for new adventures for our students!





Curriculum

At Achieve, we use the "Summit Learning" curriculum.

Our Approach? Learners for life!

Summit Learning was developed by Stanford University and is the learning platform and curriculum we use in our 4th–8th grade classrooms.

The method was developed by educators who have experience in diverse classrooms and understand every student learns differently. Based on decades of research, the Summit Learning program provides teachers and students with the resources they need to succeed. These include "a range of educational resources and technology tools, professional development for educators, and ongoing coaching and support for schools."

Summit Learning allows students to learn at their own pace, and it doesn't restrict them to one style of learning. We work with our students to determine what works best for them and ensure they thoroughly understand all of the concepts before moving on to the next skill.

There are two key components to the Summit Learning curriculum.

THE FIRST COMPONENT IS MASTERY-BASED LEARNING

In this discipline, students must show a deeper level of understanding before moving from one concept to the next. This allows students to have the whole year to master concepts and cognitive skills.

THE SECOND COMPONENT IS MENTORSHIP

With Summit, mentorship is a core teaching technique. Every week, we meet with each student for a mentoring session to discuss short and long-term goals, celebrate wins, work through any setbacks, and more. In addition, parents/guardians have access to the Summit Learning online platform, where grades, student projects, and teacher feedback can be viewed, which allows for direct involvement with progress through the school year.

However, our mentorship doesn't just stop in the curriculum. We provide the best possible support system for our students, with a focus on trauma recovery and mental health. We understand that they've been through a lot these past few years, and we want to be there as support in every aspect.


"ACHIEVE CHARTER SCHOOL IN CHICO JOINS CHICO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT"
